THIS WEEKS MESSAGE FROM MONSIGNOR ANDREW

June: Month of the Sacred Heart



June is the month of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Solemnity of which we celebrated last Friday. This devotion dates from the revelations given to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque in France in 1673-75, and affirms our faith in Jesus' humanity, and is a symbol of His love for us. The devotion makes Jesus king over our hearts and encourages us to return our love to Him, and to make reparation for our ingratitude to God.

In 2010, our Bishops invited us to pray to the Sacred Heart for all who have suffered abuse of any kind. The prayer was focused through the Litany of the Sacred Heart, with additional intercessions for all who have suffered abuse, for those who mishandled these matters and added to the suffering of those affected, and for those who have committed sins of abuse who have a journey of repentance and atonement to make. The Litany of the Sacred Heart is provided below, for prayer to the Sacred Heart during June. Also, light a candle before the statue of the Sacred Heart, for your intentions and those of others.
