
1. If you wish to buy a day pass at £6.50 only

St Aidan's Luncheon Club: The next date for our diaries will be Friday 26th July at 12 noon. By way of change this will be a Fish and Chip lunch with a dessert and the cost of that lunch will be £4.50. If you wish to attend you must sign the list at the back of the church if you (and your friends!) would like to join us.

Newman Association: The next talk of the Tyneside Circle of the Newman association is on Wednesday 31st July at 7.30pm in the church hall at St Mary's Cullercoats. Bernard Robinson will discuss "The Last Supper—the first Mass?" He will ask whether the Last Supper was a regular Passover meal or an improvised lamb less one? Is the relationship with the Eucharist more complex that is often supposed? And how does the "Passover of Egypt" relate to the Passover as celebrated afterwards (the Passover of the Generations") This talk sounds really interesting and challenging!

Once we are clear as to how long it will take to bring to completion the work on the roundabout and surrounding road and pathways outside of St Bernadette's, work will begin soon after on tarmacking a section of the driveway and car park inside the church grounds. This effectively means that when the work begins, the car park and driveway will not be in use between the Monday and the following four days.
